The Langebaan Lagoon Marine Protected Area in the Western Cape Province is the area bounded by the high-water mark and, as a northern boundary, a line running from Leentjiesklip No. 2, (33°03'.707S; 018002'.462E), towards Salamander Point (33°04'.323S; 017059'.795E), until it meets the seaward boundary of the South African National Defence Force area, as demarcated by yellow buoys (Chart SAN SC 2), and then along this boundary to the yellow buoy east of Meeu Island (33°05'.166S; 018000'.809 E), and then along a straight (line to Pertemoen Point on the western shore of Langebaan Lagoon (33°05'.590S; 048°00'.211 E).
