We request all participants to honour the rules and regulations set out in The Boatyard/Mykonos Fishing Derby to form part of supporting our ocean and environment.

## **QUALIFYING FOR PRIZES:**

1. The following fish species qualifies for the competition:
  - o White Stumpnose
  - o Steentjie
  - o Black Tail (Dassie)
  - o Cape Bream (Hottentot)
  - o Cob
2. The most species with the biggest combined weight will be the overall winner.  
(For example: A bag with 5 different fish species with a weight of 3kg qualifies higher in ranking than 3 different fish species with a weight of 5kg)
3. All fish species captured/weighed in must adhere to the minimum requirements of the law and undersized fish must be released unharmed.
4. The scale for weigh-in will take place from 14h00 – 16h00 at the Athene Conference Centre. (Remember to produce fishing permits with weigh in).
5. The scale for weigh-in of fish set out by the organizers will be seen as the official scale for the competition.
6. Only 1 bag per person is allowed to be weighed in.
7. Fish can be gutted to determine contents of the stomach.
8. Prize giving: 16H00 at the Athene Conference Centre, Club Mykonos.
9. Participants must be present at the prize giving to be awarded a prize, or will forfeit the prize with the exception of an emergency that has been approved by The Boatyard/Mykonos management.
10. The first three prize winners will be excluded from the lucky draws.

## RULES:

1. All launching will take place at Club Mykonos Marina free of charge.
2. Launching of vessels will start from 05h00 at the Marina slipway on 21 October 2023. Departure from Marina will commence at 06h00 after Skippers briefing. Space will be made available for boats to moor in Marina area.
3. Vessels may be inspected prior to launching by the event organizers.
4. Parking of boat trailers will be managed by the Marina personnel. Designated parking will be provided for the towing vehicles.
5. Entries are open to all who has a legal vessel and conform to SAMSA/SADSAA maritime regulations if required. No Shore angling allowed. All vessels taking part must comply to a valid Certificate of fitness and fishing permits (all crew to have their own fishing permit as well as the skipper to supply a vessel fishing permit).
6. Competition stickers must be clearly visible on the legal vessel and arm bands must be worn at all times.
7. The skipper of the legal vessel is responsible to ensure his crew including himself adhere to the rules and regulations set out for The Boatyard/Mykonos Fishing Derby.
8. Mykonos Marina management will not tolerate vulgar language or abuse of facilities in the Marina area.
9. The Marina area is a No Wake Zone. Please drive slowly.
10. Any dishonest acts or suspicion of foul play can result in disqualification by The Boatyard/Mykonos management. The contestant will not be eligible for any refund.
11. All persons on a legal vessel must be entered and not exceed surveyed crew capacity.
12. The fishing area consist of the complete Saldanha Bay area inside North and South head lighthouses where it is legal to fish. No fishing in National Parks Board water is allowed. (See included map)
13. Nobody is allowed to fish 24 hours prior to the competition in the National Parks Board water or competition area.
14. No fish may be swapped out between competitors or teams.
15. All fish will be marked once weighed and cannot be weighed again.
16. Entry fees will not be redeemable.
17. All decisions made by the officials will be considered as final.
